



RULES & REGULATIONS

- Courts are for pickleball **ONLY**.
- PicklePlex courts are to be used on a first come, first served basis.
- A paddle rack system is in play when courts are full. All players must use the paddle rack while others are waiting to play.
- No lessons, leagues, or tournaments without prior approval from the Valpo Parks department.
- Valpo Parks reserves the right to close the PicklePlex for events, emergencies, or when conditions necessitate.
- Valpo Parks is not responsible for personal property.
- PicklePlex may be monitored by video surveillance.
- Proper athletic attire and athletic shoes are required.
- In the event of thunder or lightning, vacate property.

STRICTLY PROHIBITED

- Alcoholic beverages, smoking, vaping or drugs
- Profanity, abusive behavior or language
- Inline skates, bikes, or skateboards
- Glass of any kind
- Spectators on the play surface
- Motorized devices
- Littering
- Posting or distribution of pamphlets, handbills or advertisements of any kind
- Amplified sound
- Animals or pets
- Drinking or eating on the play surface

who's got **next?**

If all courts are all in use,
please use the **Paddle Rack System**
to determine who plays next.

"NEXT" IS FROM LEFT TO RIGHT

- After a completed match, players should exit the court and allow new players on. If the score is not being kept, rotate off after 15 minutes.
- When the court becomes available, the paddles are moved to the left to designate the next group.
- All players must fully vacate the court at the end of a match. No new match can start without checking the paddle organizer for waiting players.
- Players finishing a match must place their paddles in the paddle organizer if they wish to play again. A player may not be on a court playing, while also having a paddle in any waiting rotation.
