Completed forms can be mailed in with Utility bill payment, or turned in to the **Valpo Parks Admin Office** at 3210 N Campbell St or the **Valparaiso City Services Office** at 205 Billings St, Monday through Friday, 8:30am to 4:30pm.

After submitting, keep an eye out within the next month for the "Tree Fund Donation" line item to appear on your monthly Utility bill. This will remain on your monthly bill until you cancel. To cancel, call the Utilities office at (219) 462-6174.
